Thank you for your participation in keeping our fantastic little town of Boylston Beautiful! We have supplied you with a clean up kit and instructions. Please be sure to read through the instructions to ensure a productive and successful clean up. When:

CLEAN UP TIMES: April 30th and/or May 1st from 8:30 am to 5 pm. Feel free to clean up anytime during these hours. Last time for trash drop off is Sunday at 5 pm.

KIT PICK UP TIME: Clean up kits and t-shirts can be picked up the morning of Saturday April 30th from 8:30-10:30 AM at the Lions Football Field Parking area (385 Main Street.) There will be a designated line to enter with your vehicle. Please do not exit your vehicle. Once you have entered the designated line, a KBB Volunteer will hand you your clean up kit through your vehicle window, assign you a cleanup area and collect your pre-filled waiver.

Your Kit Includes:

Hand sanitizer, trash bags, rubber lined gloves, trash grabber & sponsor supplied t-shirts.

Drop Off Locations:

There will be ONE clearly marked centralized drop off location for your bags once you have finished your clean up. The location has been designated as follows: The Lions Football Field, (385 Main Street) in the big red **Pleasant View Waste** dumpster. Hand sanitizer will be located at the site for your convenience.

Additional Things to Note:

Mass Department of Transportation has advised that residents of Boylston are prohibited from clean up activity along route 70.

SAFETY FIRST! This is a volunteer opportunity and you are responsible for your own safety precautions. Please use good judgment.

- Wear bright-colored clothing so that you are easily visible to passing motorists.
- Wear gloves and carry hand sanitizer with you.
- Do not attempt to pick up any hazardous materials.
- If applicable, clean one side of the road first and then cross over to clean the opposite side. Do not wander back and forth across roads. Stay off the road whenever possible.
- In the unfortunate event you come across a hypodermic needle we are asking that you do **NOT** pick it up or dispose of it in a trash bag. Report this immediately to 774-696-8305 with the location and we will have someone come and handle the disposal properly.
- The kind of trash we should be gathering is the kind that fits into bags such as wrappers, cups, bottles, cans, cartons, paper, and fast food wrappers etc. It is okay to remove stale or outdated yard sale or lost pet signs from trees or poles.
- Do not attempt to move items that are especially large or heavy (electronics, appliances, tires or anything else that does not fit into a trash bag.) Instead, email or call us and we will coordinate with the Highway Department to have the item removed.
